

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORTAGE DES SIOUX, MISSOURI, GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR OF PORTAGE DES SIOUX TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH THE ST. CHARLES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPRATMENT FOR PROVISION OF POLICE PROTECTION TO THE CITY OF PORTAGE DES SIOUX.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PORTAGE DES SIOUX, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the proposed contract between the City of Portage des Sioux and the St. Charles County Sheriff's Department be accepted and the Mayor be authorized to sign said contract. Further, the Mayor is instructed to sign said contract as soon as possible upon receipt. Contract not to exceed \$1.00 per resident per year.

SECTION II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or with any of its provisions are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION III

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen. This ordinance has received all of the required readings at the same meeting at which the Bill is introduced, so that it can be passed at one meeting. This ordinance is prima facie, deemed an emergency ordinance because it allows the aldermen to take immediate steps to prevent or to remedy conditions or situations which are of such a nature that it demands attention and to postpone action would result in serious injury or demand to the people, the government, or the municipality. The public urgency constituting the emergency involves the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare.
