## A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PUBLIC POLICY THAT ENCOURAGES GREATER INVESTMENT

WHEREAS, Consumers benefit from greater choice, better products and better prices when the communications marketplace is driven by competition between many different providers and technologies, instead of multiple layers of outmoded regulation, and

WHEREAS, high access charges result in higher long distance rates for business and residential consumers, and

WHEREAS, updating the outdated access fee scheme that hinders new investment will provide the citizens and businesses of our state better opportunity to receive the most innovative and up to date communications options to compete globally, and

WHEREAS, the City of Portage des Sioux is an organization that believes the free enterprise system is the best system available for both consumers and business, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Portage des Sioux encourages policy makers to update the current intrastate access fee structure to encourage greater competition and remove a potential barrier to greater access to communications technology and investment.
